Refunds: Up to closing date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. During competition no refunds including Acts of God. **Office fee is non refundable.**

Awards: Ribbons to 6th place all divisions. Management reserves the right to break ties. This is a series over 5 shows – special awards to the overall highpoint in all divisions. High point riders will be determined via a golf score – must participate in at least 3 shows to be eligible.

Directions: 18620 Shiloh Ranch Drive, Black Forest, CO 80908

From Hwy 83 – head east on Hodgen Road (3 miles) to Black Forest Road to the north (this will be 0.5 miles after you pass Black Forest Road to the south). Turn left onto Black Forest Road to Walker Road (1 mile) – turn right onto Walker Road (dirt road) – go for about 1 mile to T-intersection and turn left (north) – follow for about 1 mile. Shiloh Ranch will be on your left side. Follow parking instructions.

Dress is casual, however a boot with heel and ASTM safety helmet are required at all times while mounted. We reserve the right to combine, split or cancel classes based on entries. Intro and Training Level classes may be offered in small arena as well as the Eventing and Western Dressage tests.
