**Entries:** We are only accepting online entries for this show.

**Refunds:** Up to one week before show date, all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. During competition no refunds including Acts of God. *Office fee is non-refundable*.

**Awards:** Ribbons to 4th place all divisions. Management reserves the right to break ties. There will be a series highpoint over all three shows – must participate in both shows to qualify.

**Show committee:** The show committee reserves the right to cancel or split classes; limit class size; change arenas; limit the number of rides & number of horses per rider; and cancel or add judges. The show committee also reserves the right to refuse any entries. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events.

Under Colorado law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting exclusively from the inherent risks of equine activities.

**Directions:** 13710 Halleluiah Trail, Elbert, 80106

From Meridian Road - head east on Latigo Blvd to left turn onto Halleluiah Trail. You may park anywhere except in front of the indoor arena, on the side of the indoor arena and in front of the boarding barn.

Dress is casual, however a boot with heel and ASTM safety helmet are required at all times while mounted. Exception for riders in Western gear, though we highly recommend a safety helmet. We reserve the right to combine, split or cancel classes based on entries. Intro and Training Level classes may be offered in small arena as well as the Eventing and Intro and Basic Western Dressage tests. We follow USEF/WDAA rules for judging our classes. Please inquire about attire and saddlery if you have any questions. Show attire is not required.

No dogs are allowed on the show grounds.
