Office fee (non-refundable)	\$40

Stabling (per day) – vaccination required	\$50

If you are stabling: There has been an increase of EHV-1 in the United States – we therefore require proof of vaccination (flu/rhino) within 6 months of participation. We recommend that your horse has been vaccinated at least 14 days before the show to achieve immunity. You can show proof via a vet bill or the receipt of vaccine purchase if you administer it yourself.

Please note – no shavings are available – you must bring your own.

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events.

Under Colorado law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting exclusively from the inherent risks of equine activities.

Entries: We are only accepting online entries for this show.

Ride times will be sent via e-mail and posted on the website <https://www.theeleganttrider.com/>

We are using RingRadar as our new partner and show software. Go to <https://www.ringradar.com/> to enter the show. The shows will not show up before the opening date 4 weeks ahead of the show date. You will need to create an account with RingRadar.

Refunds: Up to July 17, 2026 all fees refunded except office fee. From day after closing to the day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. During competition no refunds including Acts of God. *Office fee is non-refundable.*

Awards: Ribbons to 5th place all divisions. First place prizes. Management reserves the right to break ties.

Show committee: The show committee reserves the right to cancel or split classes; limit class size; change arenas; limit the number of rides & number of horses per rider; and cancel or add judges. The show committee also reserves the right to refuse any entries. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

Directions: The Of HORSE You Can arena is located at the Denver Polo Club Fields. The address is 6359 Airport Road, Sedalia CO 80135. From Hwy 85 turn onto Airport Road at the traffic light and head west for about 0.5 miles. Turn right onto Airport Road (south) and follow road until you see the competition fields on your left. Parking is south of the competition arena and warm-up.

Parking: Day parking is close to the arena with access to water. There is very little shade, please plan ahead.

An ASTM safety helmet is required at all times while mounted (exception for Western Dressage and WE competitors over the age of 18). No dogs are allowed on the show grounds.
