Stabling

10x10 temporary stalls with doors and metal roofing. Stabling will be available for \$150 Friday – Sunday, or \$50 per day per stall. Stabling is limited and must be reserved by emailing tara@ofhorseyoucan.com. Stalls will be available on a first come, first served basis, stripping at the end of the show is included. Bedding is on sale for \$12/ bag. Stall floors are dirt, and at least one bag of bedding is required per stall. Hay can also be purchased for \$20 per bale. We offer grass and a grass/alfalfa mix.

The property

The Of HORSE You Can Arena sits on a 175-acre facility that has an upper and lower area. The stalls, trailer parking and show arena are located on the upper field and the polo field is located on the lower area. We encourage you to use the facility to its fullest extent and to stay and play for the weekend. However, the size of the facility is large, and we recommend bringing or renting a golf cart to help you get around faster. Please indicate that you would like a cart when you enter. Carts are \$130 per day. Or bring your own and we can help you keep it charged up.

Entry Procedures and the rules!

****Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes. Management reserves the right to refuse any entry. Of HORSE You Can Inc., and Denver Polo Club, the owner, their officials, and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant, or other employee, animal, or equipment at the show.**

Entries: We are only accepting online entries for this show.

Ride times will be sent via e-mail and posted on the website <https://www.theeleganttrider.com/>

We are using RingRadar as our new partner and show software. Go to <https://www.ringradar.com/> to enter the show. The shows will not show up before the opening date 4 weeks ahead of the show date. You will need to create an account with RingRadar.

****THIS WILL BE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY TO THE SHOW AND SHOW GROUNDS****

* All riders must wear ASTM Certified protective headgear while mounted.

* No alterations are to be made to stabling or other facilities by exhibitors. A \$100 fee will be charged for any changes.

* Cash and Pay pal are acceptable methods of payment. You can only pay cash for stabling/shavings/golf carts.

* No smoking is permitted inside the barns.

* **Prize money will be paid out once the class is finished. A minimum of 2 riders is required for the class to be held as a classic class.**

* **We follow USEF/USEA/WDAA rules for judging our classes. Please inquire about attire and saddlery if you have any questions.**

Fees:

Office Fee (non-refundable)	\$40

A valid Coggins (within 12 months of show date) and proof of vaccination for your horse are required.

To participate as an Adult Amateur, you need to provide a copy of your USEF Amateur card. Junior/YR must provide their birth date.

Refunds: Up to one week before the show date, all fees are refunded except the office fee. From the day after closing to the day prior to competition, class fees will be refunded only if ride(s) can be filled from wait list. During competition, no refunds including Acts of God. *Office fee is non-refundable.*

Classes: *To enter a classic class, you must have entered at least one other regular class in the same level.* High point rider of each classic class will receive all the prize money, e.g. you win class 3 you will win \$50. **Classic classes are J/A only!** Open riders need to enter the non-classic class. J/A can enter both the non-classic class and the classic class. Example an Open rider that wishes to ride Training level, test 3 would enter class 8, an Amateur can enter either class 7 or 8. To be eligible for the prize money an Amateur must enter at least one other class at the same level.

Awards: Ribbons to 6th place in all divisions. Management reserves the right to break ties.

Arena: Tests are ridden in either the large 20 m x 60 m ring or for lower level tests as well as Eventing and some WDAA tests in the 20 m x 40 m ring. Footing is sand. Warmup arena is next to competition arena with the same sand footing. Lunging will be in the open arena next to the competition ring.

Show committee: The show committee reserves the right to cancel or split classes; limit class size; change arenas; limit the number of rides & number of horses per rider; and cancel or add judges. The show committee also reserves the right to refuse any entries. Every horse entered for competition will comply with the rules of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold this horse show and the officials and employees of the show blameless for any loss or accident to his horse, employees, equipment, which may occur from sickness, fire or otherwise.

Directions: The Of HORSE You Can arena is located at the Denver Polo Club Fields. The address is 6359 Airport Road, Sedalia CO 80135. From Hwy 85 turn onto Airport Road at the traffic light and head west for about 0.5 miles. Turn right onto Airport Road (south) and follow road until you see the competition fields on your left. Parking is south of the competition arena and warm-up.

Parking: Day parking is close to the arena with access to water. There is very little shade, please plan ahead.

Schooling: Schooling Friday is free! Please indicate on your entry form if you want to school in the arena and around our beautiful facility as much as you like. Again, there is no charge for this class.

All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events.

Under Colorado law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting exclusively from the inherent risks of equine activities.

We have added a Pony division to all classes. If you have a pony card you may enter any class in the Pony division.
